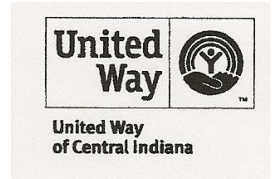


Optional: Designation Form



If you choose to designate your contribution, attach this form to your pledge form and return them both to your campaign coordinator. To ensure that your choice is considered for this campaign, it must reach United Way of Central Indiana (UWCI) by December 31.

United Way of Central Indiana gives you the option of directing your contribution. Please keep in mind that an un designated contribution is the most effective way to support the whole community - and address today's needs while reducing tomorrow's. If you choose to direct your contribution to a specific agency, we ask that you also support the entire community by specifying a portion of your contribution as undesignated.

Designation Instructions

- Fill out the form and attach it to your pledge card. United Way can process your designation only if it is specified completely and clearly on the form.
- **Only contributions to UWCI (options A, Band C below), contributions to United Way of Central Indiana's partner agencies, and contributions to other United Ways will count toward United Way's Key Club or Tocqueville Society.**
- If a chosen agency is ineligible, or if your information is incomplete or illegible, we will make every reasonable effort to contact you. If we are unable to reach you, your contribution will be considered undesignated.
- Due to the cost of processing/distributing designations, your minimum designation should total \$50 per agency. All contributions are forwarded quarterly as payment is received.
